

Paragraph 39, Section XVI (Reporting) of the effective Administrative Order on Consent between EPA and TVA specifies the use of the SCRIBE data base for all data management and reporting purposes. SCRIBE is the data base most often employed by OSC's on removal actions. Longer term response actions implemented and overseen by RPM's typically use the EQUIS data base. At the present time, both data bases are populated by environmental professionals working on the Kingston Ash Recovery Project.

This memorandum is issued to formally modify the AOC requirement regarding the use of SCRIBE. Effective immediately, all existing data in SCRIBE shall be migrated to EQUIS, and any new data shall be entered into EQUIS. As in the past, I appreciate the support and continued cooperation of TVA and its contractors in implementing this change.
