



**EPA ANNOUNCES AN EXTENSION TO THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
FOR THE AVAILABILITY OF THE  
ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND  
AGREEMENT ON CONSENT ISSUED FOR THE  
TVA KINGSTON FOSSIL FUEL PLANT RELEASE SITE  
IN ROANE COUNTY, TENNESSEE**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced today **an extension to the public comment period** for the Administrative Record for the Administrative Order and Agreement on Consent (AOC) entered into between EPA and the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) regarding the TVA Kingston Fossil Fuel Plant Release Site, in Roane County, Tennessee.

The Administrative Record file includes the AOC itself, as well as the documents which support the AOC. All interested persons are encouraged to review and comment on the documents.
