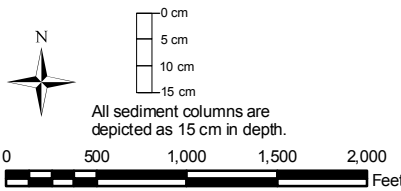
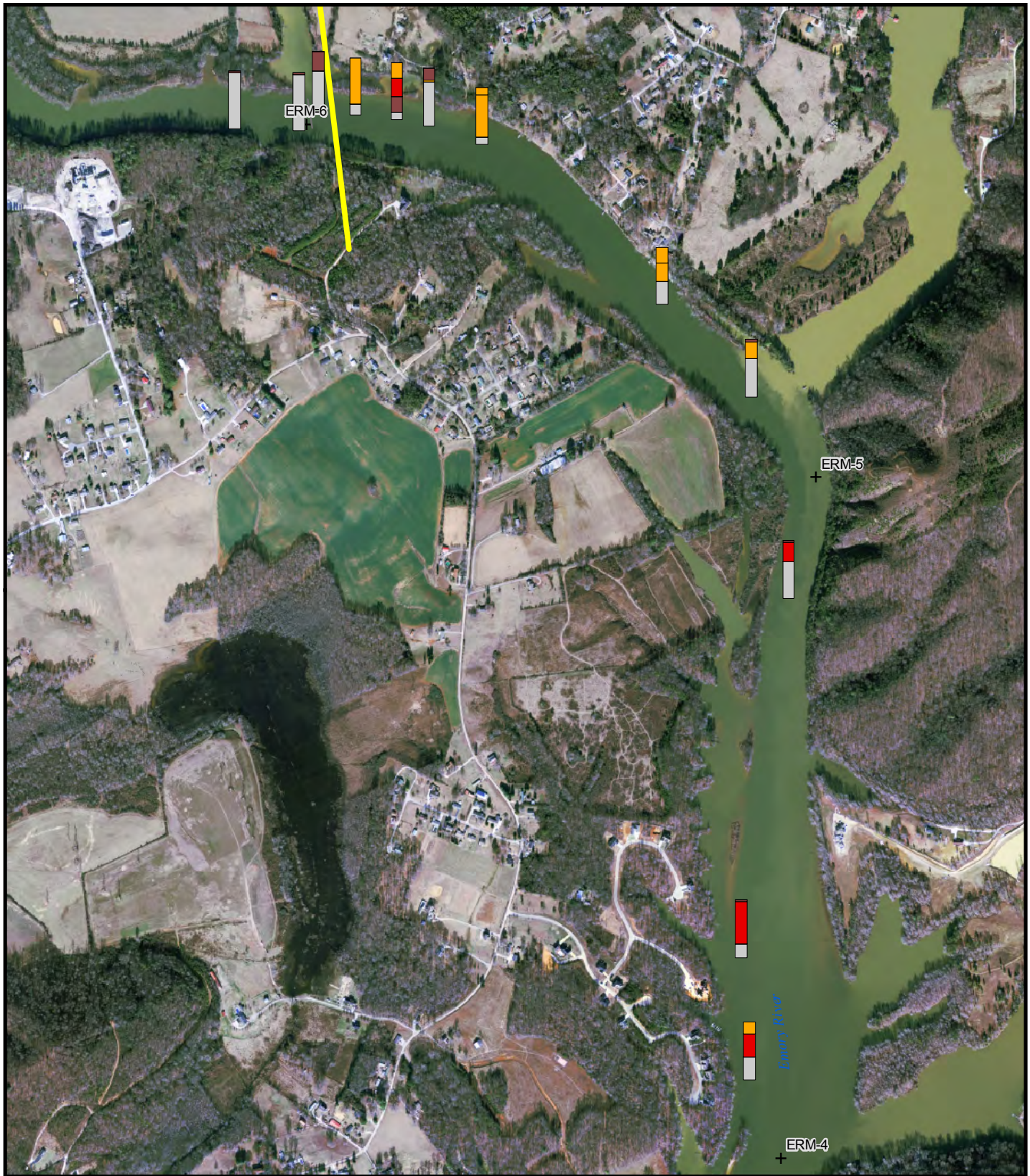


Nature and Extent of Ash in the Emory River Bottom as of August 5, 2009 (Phase 1)
